



AIM: Improve enterprise-wide outcomes while reducing costs.

SOLUTION: Using the combined data power of Premier's tools and collaboratives, leaders were able to identify inconsistencies allowing for the implementation of more comprehensive guidelines and increased communication.

RESULTS:

- ✓ C. diff rates dropped from 3.2 to 0.8
- ✓ Length of stay and mortality rates dropped from 1.8 to 0.9
- ✓ Pneumonia complication rates dropped from 1.2 to 0.5
- ✓ Value-Based Purchasing (VBP) Score improved from 19 to 52, exceeding both state and national averages
